Logistics

- At least 2 candidates for an office must be present in order for that office to be included in the session.
- Only candidates may participate and no substitutes.
- All candidates, whether opposed or not, are invited to talk with attendees.
- Campaign literature should be placed on specified tables. It may not be placed on seats or handed out to attendees as they enter or leave the room. Only small items are permitted, like cards/brochures/flyers and not yard signs/banners. Items remaining after the forum will be thrown away.
- Candidates should arrive at least 10 minutes prior to their session.
- Candidates will be seated in random order by office.
- Each candidate will have up to 1 minute for opening remarks, in the order seated, and up to 1 minute for closing remarks in the reverse order.
- Written questions from the audience will be read, and each candidate for the office addressed will have up to 1 minute to respond. The speaking order of candidates will vary.

- Candidates may respond to other candidates' remarks during their allotted speaking time but may not disparage other candidates.
- The audience may not hold candidate or party endorsement signs.
- LWV-CC may record the opening remarks and post the video online in its entirety.
